

New Perspectives of Fight against Cancer

Abstract: One has suggested that the mucus of aloe and mucus of tradescantia can be useful in the fight against cancer. One has used the fact that it infiltrates the layers of cells on the Petri pan and sticks small colonies of bacteria.

The idea of this work is easy: the creative force of the regenerating plants should break the destructive force of cancer cells and thus win the cancer.

Really: the mucus of aloe and of tradescantia sticks the cancer cells on the Petri pan and Pasteur's and Sanger's perceptivity is not necessary to convince oneself to it. This mucus sticks totally the small colonies of cells or fragments of bigger layers.

The mucus of aloe has the same flaw as all anticancer medicaments: it can attack healthy cells, too. It is the defect of this method.

The next imperfection of this method is the fact that the mucus can slip down. In this case the procedure can be repeated with the fresh mucus of these plants.

In this specific method the matter is to use the mucus of regenerating plants to fight against cancer. Generally, the way from the experiments on the Petri pan to possible clinical applications is a long way but still it is a way.
